

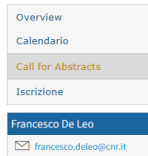
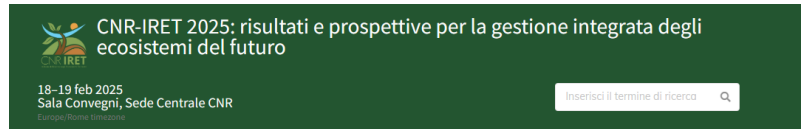



Please select up to 2 topics for your contribution and indicate at least one author and one envisaged speaker (same person, if needed). **Do not forget to upload the attachments.**



Attribute the proper role to each author/coauthor. One speaker must be selected (*microphone icon*)
